Grants are limited to persons/students from the Greater Cincinnati area, students from Scandinavia studying in the Greater Cincinnati area and persons or groups putting on Scandinavian cultural events in this area.

Deadlines

Deadlines for consideration of the scholarship application will correspond with the beginning of each month of the quarterly SSOC Foundation Board meetings as follows: April 1, July 1, October 1, and January 1.

Ten- to fifteen-minute presentations are required to be presented, after the scholarship event has occurred, for the May or September meeting of the Scandinavian Society of Cincinnati.
