Which Camp is right for your family?

Camps are offered in four Scandinavian languages and for ALL ages:

FAMILY FUN WEEK/WEEKEND

Family programs are great preparation for a family trip abroad or for a child's summer experience at the Villages. Explore family heritage or learn about an entirely new culture! Learn together and apart.

HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT CAMP (ages 14-18/grades 9-12)

It offers at least 180 hours of instruction and is designed for learners at all levels – beginning to advanced. A thematic curriculum, experiential immersion techniques and performance-based assessments are the basis for this academic program. Upon successful completion of the program, students receive a credit equivalent to one year of high school language study ; students not wishing to receive credit also must participate fully in all activities and assignments. Please note that you will need to check with your high school administrators to see if they will accept the credit at your school.

NORWEGIAN FOLK HIGH SCHOOL

Skogfjorden is the name of the Norwegian Language Village. There's no better way to learn Norwegian than to practice using practical words and phrases all day, every day. At Skogfjorden, you'll use your new Norwegian skills while canoeing on the theinnsjø (lake), playing sports and games, or learning folk dancing. You'll practice key words as you ask for seconds at mealtime or buy Melkesjokolade (milk chocolate) at the store. Immersion education will be different from every classroom you've ever been in. Here, you will completely change your surroundings and learn by doing.

YOUTH EXPLORATION CAMP (ages 7-15)

If you are a younger villager or a first-time villager, or if you're just not sure you want to be away from home for longer than a week, a one-week exploratory session will help you "ease" into the immersion atmosphere. You don't need to know any of the language when you arrive, and you'll be surrounded by other kids your age who are also interested in making friends, having fun, and trying new things. You'll enjoy the authentic meals, games, arts and crafts, sports, songs, and you'll be amazed by how much you've learned and how fast the week flies by.

Why study languages?




